Strategy	What does my teacher do?	What do I do?
<p><b>Teacher Guided</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- My teacher may say my name when they want me to read aloud to the class.</li> <li>- My teacher may ask me questions about what I've just read.</li> <li>- My teacher may read parts of the text aloud.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- I track the text so that I am prepared to read aloud.</li> <li>- When asked to read aloud I speak clearly and confidently and project my voice so others can hear.</li> <li>- I listen carefully when someone else is reading.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Paired Reading</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- My teacher may ask me and one other person to read to each other.</li> <li>- My teacher will give us a focus and an end point to read up to.</li> <li>- My teacher may give us a task to do alongside the reading.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- I track the text so that I am prepared to read aloud.</li> <li>- When it is my turn to read aloud I use a strong voice, but don't drown out those around me as they are also in paired reading.</li> <li>- I listen carefully when my partner is reading.</li> <li>- If appropriate, I may use a highlighter or a coloured pen to select key words or features.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Silent Reading</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- My teacher may ask me to read silently.</li> <li>- My teacher will give me a focus and an end point to read up to.</li> <li>- My teacher may give me a task to do alongside the reading.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- I am silent and respectful to those around me.</li> <li>- I read slowly and carefully so that I don't miss anything important from the text.</li> <li>- If appropriate, I may use a highlighter or a coloured pen to select key words or features.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Group Reading</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- My teacher may ask me to work in a small group with others.</li> <li>- My teacher may give us different roles in the group.</li> <li>- My teacher will give us a focus and an end point to read up to.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- I track the text so that I am prepared to read aloud.</li> <li>- When it is my turn to read aloud I use a strong voice, but don't drown out those around me as they are also in group reading.</li> <li>- I listen carefully when other members of the group are reading.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Teacher Modelling</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- My teacher may read aloud to us to show us really effective ways to read the text.</li> <li>- My teacher may read from the start of the text so that high expectations are established.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- I listen carefully to the way my teacher is reading. I might make notes using a highlighter or coloured pen to remind me of key hints and tips.</li> <li>- I track the text so that I am prepared to read aloud.</li> <li>- When it is my turn to read aloud, I use my teacher's model as a guide.</li> </ul>
