### **High Expectations**

We started this week with our on-boarding assemblies to welcome all the students back to the Academy and provide a reminder of our expectations. We were very proud to see how the vast majority of our students have come well-prepared and ready to learn, with the correct equipment and standard of uniform. We would like to thank our Parents/Carers for supporting us with these standards and expectations for uniform and equipment from the very start of this academic term.

With that in mind, may I politely remind you that as per our existing uniform policy, students must not wear any jewellery apart from a pair of small stud earrings in the lower lobe of the ear. Hoop earrings, 'drop' earrings, necklaces and bracelets are **not** permitted for health and safety reasons and therefore will be confiscated.

In addition, where a student has a piercing in the nose that is not in line with this policy, they will be expected to remove it and wear a small plastic retainer. If a student has had their jewellery confiscated this will be put into a labelled envelope and stored in the pastoral safe. Students can collect the items at the end of the day from reception and we would request that any confiscated items are kept at home in future, and not brought back into school.

## **Enrichment**

We are launching a new register system this half term for all enrichment clubs. Parents/Carers have already received communication about how to sign up their children using the new system. Our enrichment programme is designed to enhance students' academic experience and develop life skills such as teamwork, resilience and organisation.
