Full Crew

This week's Full Crew had a deliberate teaching and learning focus. In the build up to our end of year assessment and exams we explored the difference between recalling knowledge and applying knowledge to given scenarios and tasks. We zoomed in on the 'powerful connections' that occur when we link what we already know about a topic with new information we are taught. This process strengthens long term memory and understanding.

Exciting Curriculum News

A selected group of Year 9 students have been experimenting this week with Kitronik console, a programmable gamepad for students to learn how to code. The feedback from the Year 9s who have had the opportunity to use this device has been very positive and we are now looking forward to incorporating this unit of work into our KS3 curriculum next year.
