Excellence Fortnight

As we approach the end of this academic year, we have launched a second round of 'Excellence' fortnight, to give students the opportunity to demonstrate excellence in their conduct, attendance and uniform standards. To achieve 'excellence status' over the next two weeks, students will have to achieve:

- Excellence standards of behaviour, therefore receiving no C1s or C2s
- Excellence standards of attendance, achieving 98% over the next two weeks
- Excellence standards of equipment, arriving to school with a rucksack, a filled pencil case with two black or blue pens, two pencils, a ruler, a rubber, and a pencil sharpener.
- Excellence standards of uniform, therefore receiving no C1s for skirt rolling, untucked shirts, misuse of blazers or incorrect footwear (i.e.) trainers etc.

Last term, students who achieved the excellence standard took part in an Easter Prize Draw. This time, we have decided to reward everyone who achieves the excellence standard with an ice-cream, which will be very much welcome and appreciated if the temperatures continue to be high.



Assemblies

In our Full Crew assemblies this week, we have celebrated diversity and identity. Mrs Kent spoke to the children about individuality and how some identity and diversity features can easily be seen, whilst some cannot; therefore, we should never assume. We touched on the themes of relationships in terms of connections and attachments - friendships, families, romantic and explored how some attachments are healthy and some are unhealthy.
