## **Key Stage 3 Assessments**

One of our priorities this half term is Key Stage Three assessments. Our Year 7, Year 8 and Year 9 students will be undertaking a range of 'high stake' summative assessments in all their subjects. These assessments will start on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> November and finish on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> December. The second summative assessment window is scheduled for the summer term.

These assessments will be completed in classrooms/learning spaces under teacher supervision. Teacher feedback will ensure all students understand what they have done well and the specific steps they need to take to improve. Our summative assessments are designed to allow teachers to evaluate the extent to which students

- have learned/remembered core knowledge and
- can now use and apply this core knowledge in increasingly complex ways.

We know you will be keen to support your child with their preparation for these assessments and we will be emailing you a revision list next week.

Finally, this week we received confirmation from the Local Authority of the numbers of Year 6 applications and I am delighted to share with you that first and second choices have increased again this year. We have exceeded our Year 7 PAN (pupil admission number) with first choices alone which is a testament to the reputation of the school and the hard work and talent of all our staff members. We are humbled by the trust and confidence that parents in our community have placed on our school and we will continue to provide excellent education to our students.
